

English

We will meet our friend Fred the frog this half term, he will be helping us to learn our letter sounds starting with m,a,s,d and t. We will learn how to say, read, and write these sounds each day in our Read Write Inc lessons. Fred will play games with us, which will support us to hear these sounds and Fred talk to make words e.g.

Fred says touch your b-a-ck.

Reading and rhymes

This half term we will spend lots of time-sharing stories together. We will look at stories with repetition such as 'The Ginger-bread Man' and 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. We will explore feelings and emotions through 'The Colour Monster' and 'Guess How Much I Love You.'

<u>Maths</u>

This half term we will begin our Maths No Problem! journey looking at the skills of matching and sorting to start with. We will move onto exploring pattern, comparing, and ordering items by height, length and finish with counting forwards and backwards to 5, ordering numerals and writing them.

<u>RE</u>

In R.E this half-term, we will start by thinking about how God knows and loves each one of us, and the importance of our name. We will explore through topic 2 belonging. Belonging within a family, a school community, the wider community, and the parish community. We will learn and think about Baptism and the special items used within a baptismal service such as the white garment and the font.
