Knowledge and understanding of the Wold

We will be exploring the Arctic regions of our world. What the climate is like, which animals live there and the features they have that make them suited to being in the cold, snowy climate of the Arctic. We will investigate ice and think about the different ways we can make it melt. We will learn about the season of Winter comparing it to the previous season of Autumn and observe the changes we can see in our environment. We will explore colour and texture to make 'cold' paintings and collages and paint our favourite snowy animals

English

Fred the frog this half term, will be helping us to secure our single letter sounds a-z. We continue using our Fred Talk to orally blend sounds into words and play Fred games to practise this skill and support our 'Fred Talk Read the Word'. When we can Fred Talk Read the Word, we will bring home our sound blending books to show you how amazing we are and hope you will support us on our reading journey by listening to us read each day. Fred will begin to teach us about 'Special Friends' these are two letters that sit next to each but only make one sound.

Reading and rhymes

We will look at stories with characters and settings from cold climates.

We will met 'Ted' this little puppet will support us to learn new vocabulary by playing games and listening to stories together.

We will explore audio books using our listening centre and story phones in class and continue singing our favourite songs, learn new ones from Cherranga and share our news.

Maths

This half term in maths no problem we will be continuing our journey within the number system. Looking at counting up to 10, representing 10 with objects, our fingers and on a tens frame. We will deepen our understanding of number looking at what number 6 is made of (e.g. 5+1, 3+3...) We will compare quantities finding 1 more or 1 fewer and then moving onto addition using the counting all strategy when combining two groups of objects. We will also order numbers to 10 and continue practising our number formation.

RE

In R.E this half-term, we will start by thinking about celebrations some key questions we will be thinking about are

What is a celebration?

Why do people celebrate?

Can you celebrate on your own? We will look at what our parish family celebrates, and we will listen to the presentation story when Mary and Joseph took baby Jesus to the Temple.
