

## A Year 6 musician will:

In Key Stage 1	<ul> <li>Play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using voice and playing instruments with increasing accuracy, control and expression</li> <li>Improvise and compose music using inter-related dimensions of music separately and in combination</li> <li>Listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory</li> <li>Use and understand the basics of the stave and other musical notations</li> <li>Appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music from different traditions and from great musicians and composers</li> <li>Develop and understanding of the history of music</li> </ul>
<b>Perform</b> This concept involves understanding that music is created to be performed	<ul> <li>Sing a harmony part confidently and accurately</li> <li>Sustain a drone or melodic ostinato to accompany singing</li> <li>Perform with controlled breathing (voice) and skilful playing (instrument)</li> </ul>
<b>Compose</b> This concept involves appreciating that music is created through a process which has a number of techniques	<ul> <li>Combine a variety of musical devices including melody, rhythm and chords</li> <li>Thoughtfully combine elements for a piece in order to gain a defined effect</li> <li>Use drones and melodic ostinati (based on the pentatonic scale)</li> <li>Use digital technologies to compose, edit and refine pieces of music</li> </ul>
<b>Transcribe</b> This concept involves understanding that compositions need to be understood by others and that there are techniques and a language for communicating them	<ul> <li>Use the standard musical notation of crotchet, minim and semibreve to indicate how many beats to play</li> <li>Understand the purpose of the treble clef and bass clef and use them in transcribing compositions</li> <li>Understand and use the sharp (# )and flat (b)symbols</li> </ul>
Appraise/Describe Music This concept involves appreciating the features of musical elements	<ul> <li>Choose from a wide range of musical vocabulary and accurately describe abd appraise music</li> <li>Timbre</li> </ul>
