The children will learn all about how to make simple and parallel circuits whilst investigating how to change the brightness of a bulb. The topics will build on the children's prior knowledge. They will have 'hands-on-experiences' and use their investigative skills to support their learning.	In R.E this half-term, we will be thinking and learning about loving families and how this relates to known loving families in the Bible. We will also look at our Monthly Values in depth and think about how these link to the Bible and our everyday lives. After half-term, we will learn about the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation.

During this half-term, we will be looking at Ancient Greece. We are going to compare the city states of Athens and Sparta and how democracy was born before going on to look at the impact the Ancient Greeks have on the modern world. Our Geography topic will be Coastlines, continuing our focus on Greece. We will look at where land meets water and how waves, tides, and currents help create coastlines. Both topics will incorporate Art skills based on drawing, painting and collage.	On Thursdays, we will be going swimming so please ensure that children remember their swimming costumes and towels. Any child with hair that is long enough to go in their eyes must also bring a swimming cap to wear. P.E. is on a Friday afternoon - please make sure your child has their kit, (including suitable footwear) in school. Please remove all jewellery.	Miss Murphy will teach your children on Mondays and Tuesdays and Mr Houghton on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Homework</u></p> Your child <u>must</u> complete their homework. If homework is not handed in on the allocated day your child will miss Friday lunchtime until their homework is complete. We run a homework club on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday lunchtimes.
